ref: Viscount Horatio Nelson (1758-1805), English naval hero, who in 1805 destroyed the combined French and Spanish fleets off Cape Trafalgar near Gibraltar, and was killed in action. This tune was collected in Ireland later in the nineteenth century and thought by O'Neill to be a variation of "The Cloone Hornpipe", but it was in fact actually in honor of Admiral Nelson, and appeared in Riley's *Flute Melodies Volume Two* (1817), in this accepted key.
